1.1. About this document

2 SPECIFICATIONS

2.1. Use

LM Transit series one-time use portable temperature data loggers are capable of storing 16000 data records with 15 minutes of pre-fixed store interval. Ideal for recording temperature during shipping and transport, LM Transit series are easy to use, accurate and affordable solutions for your requirements. Waterproof (IP65) ensures that you can place them in the most demanding of environments. This logger comes pre-programmed from factory and user just needs to pull the tap to start recording data. The bright fluorescent like color makes it easy to identify at destination for easy retrieval.

The associating LMView software helps to download the stored data and review them by PC.

3 UNPACKING THE PRODUCT

3.1 Unpacking and Inspection of LM Transit Data Logger

- LM Transit data logger is dispatched in a recyclable, environment friendly package specially designed to give adequate protection during transit.
- If the outer box shows sign of damage, it should be opened immediately, and the device be examined. If the device is found damaged, it should not be operated, and the local representative contacted for instructions.
- Ensure that all accessories and documentation are removed from the box.
- If the LM Transit data logger is for immediate use, you can start installing it as per Installation instructions.
- **Please preserve the original packaging along with all internal packing for future transport requirements.**

3.2 Mechanical Dimensions of LM Transit Data Logger

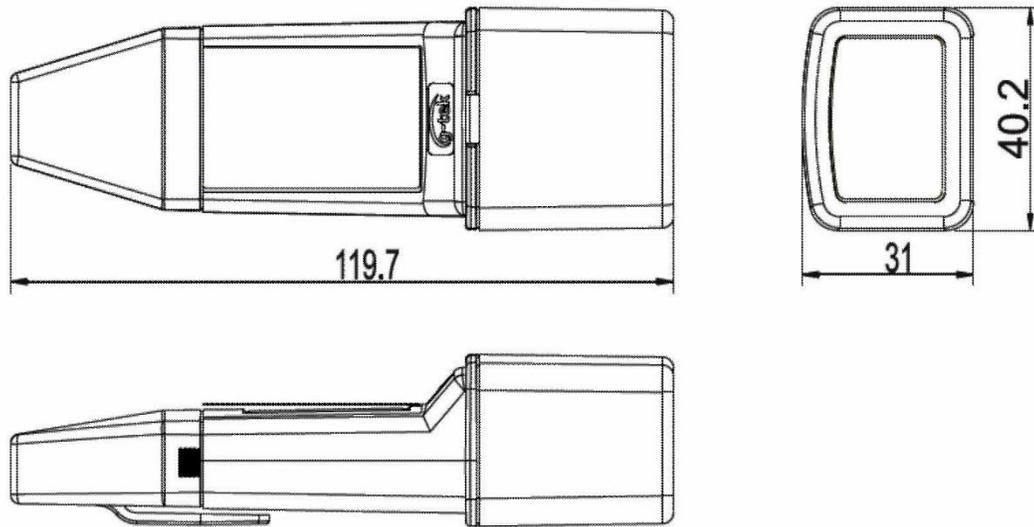


Figure 2 Overall Dimensions of LM Transit Data Logger

3.3 Connect LM Transit with PC

- Remove the USB cover from the top of the LM Transit.

- Connect LM Transit Directly to the PC via USB or Connect Through The USB extension port.

- After downloading the Data, disconnect the device from PC and place USB cover back on the LM Transit.

3.4 Battery Saving Mode

- The battery life of LM Transit is about 1 Year at 25°C Temperature if the data is stored at the interval of 15 minutes and downloaded once every month.
- The data is updated in LM at every Store Interval. LM goes in battery saving mode between reading Intervals.
- While communicating with PC, it starts running on USB power supply. Until you disconnect the USB Cable it will run in normal mode with USB power supply and it again switches back to the battery saving mode after disconnecting.

4 MAINTAINING THE PRODUCT

4.1 Accessories

- Battery (3V, 225 mAh; CR2032 coin cell)

4.2 Cleaning the Data Logger

Ensure that no liquid enters inside the housing.

- If the housing of Data logger gets dirty, clean it with damp cloth.
- Do not use any aggressive cleaning agents or solvents.
- When USB port is not in use, cover the USB port properly.

4.3 Changing the Battery

The typical life of the battery is about 1 Year. If the data is sampled more frequently at Sub Zero Temperature then the battery life will be considerably reduced.

- To replace the battery, open the Sensor cover of LM Transit.

- Slide out the used old battery from LM Transit.
- Slide in the new battery with correct polarity (+ marking should be visible on the top side).

- Close sensor cover of LM tightly.

Note: The data is retained in the Nonvolatile memory and even after replacing the battery user can download the previously stored data.

4.4 Battery Disposal

- Dispose or recycle the battery in accordance with your local regulations.
- Do not expose the Data Logger to extreme temperatures as it may lead to the destruction of the battery and may cause injuries.
